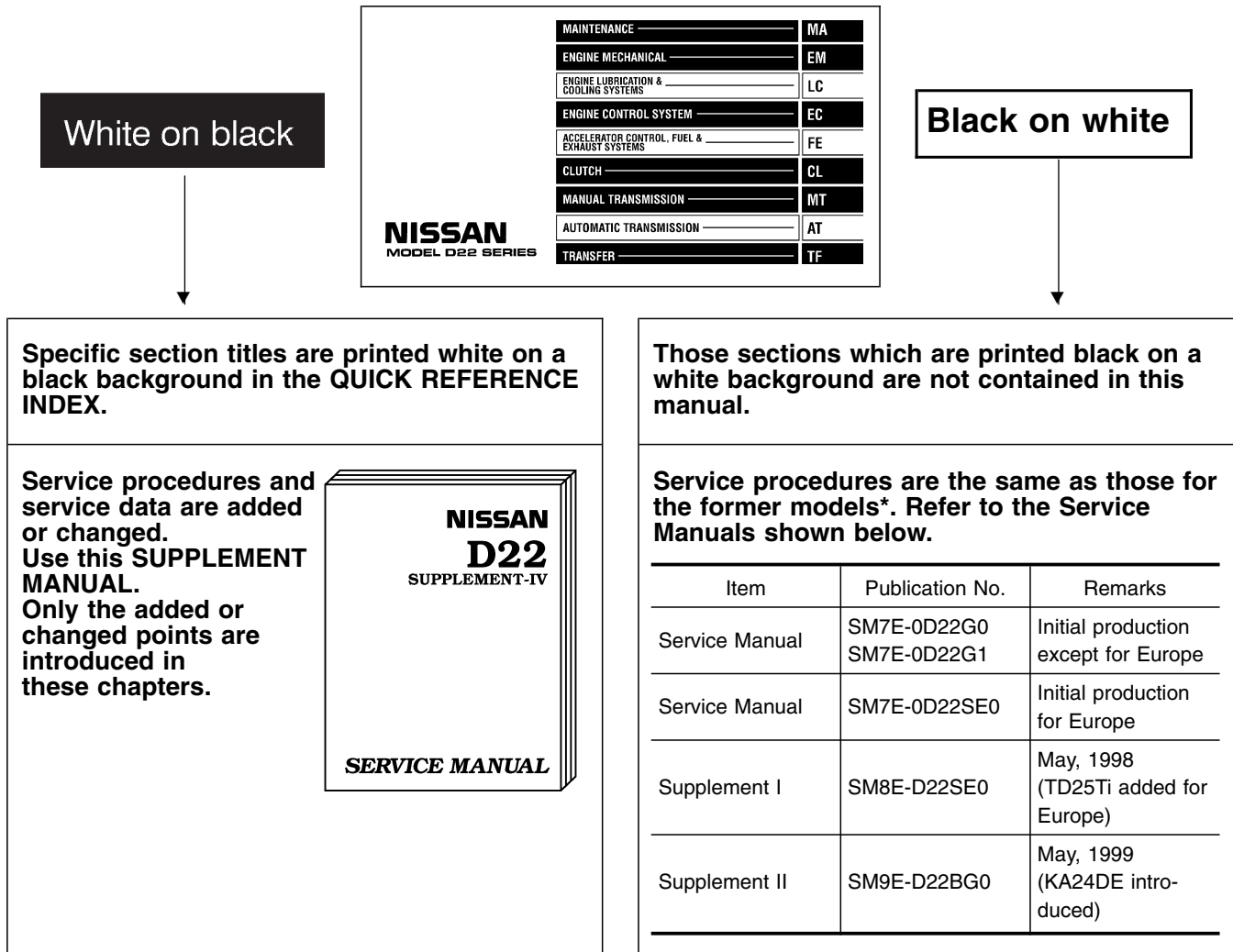

- ▶ This Service Manual does not contain the service procedures, etc. which are the same as those for former models\*.  
Please use this manual in conjunction with the NISSAN model D22 series Service Manual (Pub. No. SM7E-0D22SE0, SM7E-0D22G0 and SM7E-0D22G1), Supplement-I (Pub. No. SM8E-D22SE0) and Supplement-II (Pub. No. SM9E-D22BG0).
